**A 30% commission will be placed on all artwork sold at the MADArt gallery.**

**All artists who exhibit must staff the gallery for 4 hours for each show in which you have artwork.**

You must sign up for staffing when you bring in artwork for a show. If you can not staff the gallery for a show, you must pay an additional \$32 fee to cover the cost of staffing the gallery for that show. (Note: The Holiday Show, Nov.- Dec. will require 6 hours of staffing from every artist exhibiting.)
